Eligibility - preschool age 3 - 8th grade

Must be a registered student of Zion Lutheran School, member of Zion Lutheran Church, or referred by a Zion family with approval from the school principal. Preschool students must be at least 3 years of age by the start date of the program and completely potty-trained.

Fees and Costs

Registration Fee: \$50.00 per child (non-refundable)
Includes 1 summer program T-shirt; additional T-shirts available at \$10.00 each*

*Register by May 15 to ensure the proper size for your child.

Vacation Bible School Fee: \$20.00 per child
Zion's Vacation Bible School (VBS) is June 14-17. Summer Program participants attending that week MUST participate in VBS. Registration will take place at a later date.

Program Costs: Charged on a daily basis with discounts for multiple days of attendance per week and two or more children registered.

Activities

Our summer program has weekly topics with STEM activities for all age groups. Other activities include weekly chapel or daily devotions, art, virtual field trips, playground time, games, special guests, and quiet time. All children will take weekly field trips to local parks.

Safety Measures

Children will be in separate grade groups and maintain social distancing as much as possible. Masks will be worn. Sanitation measures will continue as during the school year.

Snacks and Lunch

The cost for attending the Summer Program includes morning and afternoon snacks every day for all children. Lunch is provided every Monday. Please let us know of any allergies so that we may provide an appropriate snack/lunch. Parents are asked to provide a filling lunch with a beverage (no soda please) every Tuesday-Friday or when the Monday lunch is not preferred for the child. If a child forgets to bring lunch, the Summer Program will provide a lunch for a \$5 fee, which will be billed. The staff will attempt to contact the parents before providing this lunch.
